New Play equipment in place

Following consultation with the children at Littlebourne School, the winning climbing frame, which received 63% of the children's votes, has now been installed by HAGS in time for everyone to enjoy this summer.



LPC applied for some funding for this project from Canterbury City Council and were awarded £7440 towards this new item of equipment and the resurfacing under the existing slide. The igloo climbing frame was beyond repair and the safety surface under both items was no longer up to scratch. We now have this new climbing frame with wet pour safety surfacing under and shiny new wet pour surfacing under the slide.

The List Development latest

As you have probably noticed 42 and 42a The Hill are well on the way to being fully removed, the access road into the development can then be created. Start time on site expected to be June with a programme of 2 ½ years subject to sales.

Open Space land; the bottom piece of land is taken up completely by the attenuation pond so there is no longer any land available for LPC. Leath Park will retain responsibility and maintain the attenuation pond and surrounding green areas. Leath Park will also retain and maintain the green strip of land that runs along the side of the list track (to the LHS). The top piece of land from the bottom corner of the Evenhill estate across to St Vincent's and above will be transferred to LPC. Although the transfer of ownership is planned soon, it will become open to the village later in The List development timeframe; the developers will be landscaping and planting native trees on part of it

before finally handing over to the village. This will then be maintained by LPC.

Parking on The Hill

A polite reminder to all those who park on The Hill, especially with the changes afoot to the road layout with the access road to the List development. Please ensure there is sufficient room for pushchairs and mobility scooters to pass along the pavement. No one wants to see parents with children or the elderly forced into the road to pass cars blocking the pavements.
