It is in fact a fibre optic cabinet put in under a scheme by KCC & BT, part of the 'make Kent guicker' campaign to enable us to get superfast broadband in our homes and businesses. The aim is to achieve superfast broadband for 95% of properties across the county in the next 18 months.
